





Proposition 1 Sustainable Groundwater Planning Grant Program

Final Awards – 2017 Grant Solicitation

- Awarded \$85.8 million to 78 applicants
 - \$16.2 million to severely disadvantaged communities
 - \$69.6 million toward GSP development of which \$27.5 million to 18 critically overdrafted basins
- Next Steps
 - Grant Agreement Execution
 - Conduct work



Proposition 68 Funding

- Passed in June 2018
- Authorized \$50M for extension of Sustainable Groundwater
 Planning Grant Program
 - Tentative Schedule: Draft Proposal Solicitation Package (PSP) early 2019
 - Fund activities that support the development of a GSP
 - Likely priority to GSAs that did not receive Prop 1 grant
- Authorized ~\$100M for Sustainable Groundwater Implementation
 Grant Program
 - Tentative Schedule: Draft PSP late 2019/early 2020
 - Fund projects and programs that will assist GSAs implement a GSP
 - Likely priority to GSAs in critically overdrafted basins


Proposition 3 Funding?

- On November 2018 Ballot
- Would Authorize additional funding for Sustainable Groundwater Planning Grant Program
 - Actual amount available for award is TBD, but likely ~\$60M
- Would Authorize additional funding for Sustainable Groundwater Implementation Grant Program
 - Actual amount available for award is TBD, but likely ~\$500M
 - Schedule TBD

- Single Contact for Each Basin
- Coordination within Basin

- TSS addressing data gaps & technical needs
- Funding decisions made a on continuous basis


